

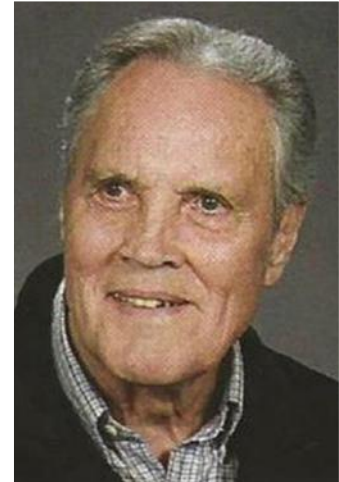
Rich Fleming
